The transfer of portfolio took place according to and observed the applicable legal provisions, including, among others, Directive 2005/56/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 26 October 2005 On Cross-Border Mergers Of Limited Liability Companies, Regulation 14 of the European Communities (Cross-Border Mergers) Regulations 2008, the provisions of Act CXL of 2007 of Hungary, as amended, and the Slovene Insurance Act (Ul RS 13/00 et al) regarding the portfolio transfer between insurance undertakings, as subsequently amended and completed.
